MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Wanstead Model Flying Club is predominately a fixed wing club and as such, any person joining will have to be a member for 2 years and passed the BMFA 'A' test in Fixed Wing & Helicopter before being allowed to fly (single rotor) Helicopters.

No members are allowed to fly solo until they have passed their BMFA 'A' test (this applies to fixed wing, multirotors & helicopters). You are required by law to have a spotter with you if flying FPV (First Person View)

General Information:

We hold monthly club meetings and indoor flying sessions, details can be found on our website under "Events" or contact the Club Secretary for up to date details.

It is important for you to attend the meetings in order to keep up to date with all aspects of the club activities, the AGM is usually held in November/December each year. Membership renewals are taken at the AGM, December and January meetings. The last date for renewals is the February meeting.

Membership will lapse if renewal is not made by the February meeting. Any renewals made after the cut off date will be subject to an extra £10 late filing admin fee.

Flying times are 10.30am - dusk on Mon, Tues, Wed, & Fri. 1pm - dusk on Sat & Sun. No flying is permitted at all on Thursdays.

We have club instructors available by appointment for teaching members to fly and pass their BMFA 'A' Test. You will need to ensure that you have a compatible transmitter and/or a buddy-lead.

Upon your successful application to the club, it will be your responsibility to read and familiarise yourself with the club's constitution & rules which can be downloaded from our website. Initial membership will be for a probationary period of 12 months with a review at 6 months. Failure to use the club's facilities or any breach of club rules, or any behaviour not in keeping with the club's constitution may result in loss of membership. When flying, you must be in possession of your Epping Forest Permit & have the relevant BMFA & CAA insurance cover. You may be asked to show proof of these by a club official or a park ranger.

Please do not turn on any radio equipment unless you are sure that you will not interfere with any other models in the air.

You must check with any FPV pilots which frequency they are using so that you do not clash.

Above all, common-sense and respect for users of Wanstead Flats, including other members, wildlife and the public is the attitude that the club expects from all of our members. Please also remember to keep the site tidy.
